Vehicle Rate/Passenger Rate:

Horse boxes (including vehicles towing a horse trailer) shipped for wholly non-commercial use (ie. Competition, holiday or moving your own horse) would be charged at the applicable private rates.

Fares

All fares are subject to availability at the time of booking.

All fares maybe subject to amendment fees or a difference in fare if the customer requests changes to the booking details. However, whereby a booking has to be changed due to the Master's refusal of livestock, the amendment fees/increase in fare will be waivered by the company.

All fares will be subject to the terms and conditions of the relevant fare, please see our website for further details.

Fuel Surcharge

The fuel surcharge is reviewed quarterly revisions coming into effect January, April, July and October.

Securing Points

The vehicle must have adequate securing points to secure the vehicle to the vessel to ensure stability.

The requirement of securing points will depend on the size of the vehicle. The Freight Operations team will offer advice if required. An information leaflet is available upon request or further information from our Freight team if required.

NB: If a vehicle does not have adequate securing points then it may be refused shipment.

Access to / Exiting ports.

You are required to have photographic ID (passport or driving licence) and be wearing hi-vis to gain access to the ports.

To exit the port of Heysham you will be required to present a paper copy of your booking confirmation with your vehicle registration written on the paperwork.

Confirmation of shipment of livestock:

The decision to accept livestock for shipment is made by the Master based on the latest forecast to the relevant sailing.

The freight operations staff will try and obtain a decision as soon as possible.

An import licence is required to import livestock into the Isle of Man, this can be obtained from DEFA. The original import licence must be presented and handed in upon check-in at Heysham.
